- Our journey started in the year 1990. Former Indian Prime Minister Mr. Chandrasekar visited our project village Brahmadesam on 13th June, 1990 and encouraged us and supported our social awareness programmes.
- Chief functionary of **Terre des Hommes**, Netherlands Mr. Luie Brunes visited us on 29th November, 1992 for the second time and supported us to initiate child care and vocational centre for women.
- In 1992, Alathur block, we have established **industrial leather gloves production training unit** through which many poor women got employment.
- With the financial support of **Trichy DRDA**, we implemented **social forestry programme** during 1993-1994.
- In the same year, Veppanthattai block, we trained women and youth on **mushroom cultivation**, which helped them to relieve them from poverty.
- During 1994-2000, with the support of Perambalur DRDA, we established leather products producers association and milch animal producers federation under golden jubilee DWCRA scheme
- During 2001-2004, with the support of Central Government under DWCRA scheme, we established Indian Leather Products and supplied gloves to Dalmia Ceramics over more than 10 years.
- By availing one-time grant from TN social welfare department, women got selfemployment training
- In the same period, IGMI has facilitated the rural economy through milch animal milk producer's cooperative, issuing revolving fund to procure cows, milk collection centres.
- This milk producers cooperative get a place in the **Poomalai Commercial Complex** to sell their value added milk products.
- With the support of World Vision India, IGMI constructed in-let channel for the Brahmadesam panchayat. Because of this the lake was able to catch hold more rainwater during rainy season, and the water level in the nearby irrigation wells increased and contributed heavily to meet the agriculture water requirements.
- During 2005-2006, with the support of TN social welfare department, we conducted Awareness generation programme (AGP) for rural poor women in Brahmadesam village.
- In 2007-2008, we conducted **awareness programme in drought prone areas** in Ariyalur district.
- We were functioning as **Business Facilitator for State Bank of India** in 2008-2012 and introduced 4000 savings bank account during these 5 years period.
- During 2012-2018, as Business Correspondent of State Bank of India, IGMI has facilitated, nearly 900 people to get monthly old age pension.
- With the support of NABARD bank and Trichy Cooperative Central Bank we conducted NABARD-FIP-dFLAP Programme which introduced cashless transactions among our target communities in Perambalur district.
- During 2006-2008, with the support of NABARD bank, under watershed programme, IGMI implemented Capacity Building Phase in Nattarmangalam and subsequently during 2010-2018, we completed Full Implementation Phase. Under these phases, we

have established percolation ponds, farm ponds, gully bunds, mud bunds, through which the **rain water harvesting** was ensured; through tree plantations, green coverage was ensured; and through **revolving fund**, milch animals and goats for the landless, readymade garment production training, etc. the village economy increased as well the capacity, skill development, economic development of the rural poor increased.

Currently in 2022,

- With the support of NABARD and KfW German bank, IGMI get sanction to implement Climate Change Adaptation Programme (KfW Soil Project) to the tune of 59 lakh rupees in three years period.
- With the support of Antenna Trust we are supporting women Self Help Groups / Joint Liability Groups for the Micro Credit Facility at Perambalur District.
- Under the supervision of NABARD and jointly with another NGO, we availed Rs. 10 lakhs from Canara Bank-Perambalur to rear milch animals for 20 poor women. In agreement with Chakra Diary Farm, we market 600 liters of milk every day in collaboration with Khadyota Kishan Foundation, Coimbatore, a non-govt. company incorporated with the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India. We run Fair Price Shop (Ration Shops) since 9th February, 2020 which is very useful for the farmers.
